



Description of Work

The provision of work refers to the landscaped portions of the properties: Yellow Fever Cemetery, Parcel #44340, St. George's Parish, Ferry Point Cottage Cemetery Parcel #44341, St. George's Parish, Grenadier Lane Military Cemetery, Parcel #23549, St. George's Parish, and Secretary Lane Military Cemetery, Parcel #44338, St. George's Parish (the **Property**). The landscaped areas subject to this Agreement are outlined in blue and can be seen in Schedule 2.

We shall allow full access to the Property for the purposes of landscaping in accordance with this Agreement.

Work will be completed monthly by you.

You have the option to discontinue providing Work under this Agreement if we schedule any works that would render any Work unnecessary during the Term.



SCHEDULE 2

Statement of Work

1. You shall furnish all labour, tools, specialized equipment, material, supplies, supervision and transportation to perform landscape maintenance services as specifically outlined in this Agreement.
2. We anticipate a minimum of 18 mowings during the term of this Agreement. Two (2) in the months of , May, June, July, August, September and October and one (1) in the month of April, November, December, January, February, and March with the final cut on or before March 15th. If locations need additional service, it will be outside of this Agreement it will require prior written consent before work can be completed.
3. You will be required to produce in writing the dates you have provided Service at any site. This can be an email, a statement or the invoice itself if it breaks out the details on the invoice.
4. It is your responsibility to remove all litter and debris before and after providing each Service. Bagging of the litter is required and care should be used to avoid blowing clippings into any of the porches, walkways, flower beds, sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots.
5. All areas around trees, shrubs, buildings, posts, fences, flower beds, sidewalks and curbs will be edged with lawn trimmers after each mow.
6. You will be responsible for replacement of trees, shrubs or bushes damaged by inappropriate mowing or edging.
7. You will promptly repair, at their cost, any damages to turf or vegetation.
8. All grass clippings shall be removed from all play area equipment, porches, beds, walkways, sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots after each mowing.
9. Waste will be removed from the site after each visit.
10. Invasive species will be removed from any hardscape feature each visit.
11. Pruning invasive or exotic trees as required to prevent them from overhanging or encroaching onto the wall or around native and endemic trees and shrubs.
12. You will advise our Contact at site of the need for reseeding or re-sodding of any areas.
13. All turf areas inaccessible to mowing equipment will be trimmed prior to mowing as needed to maintain a neat, well-groomed appearance. No strimmers are to be used around the headstones or limestone walls.
14. You shall supply all herbicides, fertilizers, chemicals and the like for servicing the facilities that meet our approval. No chemicals will be used around the headstones themselves.
15. You shall supply all necessary data sheets and meet requirements to comply with laws and regulations.
16. You shall not dump any debris into any containers.



17. The entrance drive, parking areas, sidewalks, curbs and other hard surfaces shall be kept free of leaves, litter and debris. The use of power blowers is acceptable, however, accumulations of debris must be removed from the site and not blown onto adjacent property, street surfaces, sewer drains, fence lines or planting areas.
18. Undesired vegetation in sidewalks, curbs, cracks and other hard surfaces need maintained so there are no weeds growing in them. You can use safe and acceptable herbicide e.g. Roundup, on them or cut them with a weed whip.
19. Mow all grass in all common areas of the property completely to maintain a uniform height not to exceed between 2 to 3 inches.
20. No trimmers to be used around any headstones or plants on site.
21. Apply an effective, safe and environmentally friendly herbicide to immediately kill all grass and weeds growing up through cracks and openings in sidewalks, curbs, roads, parking areas, walls, etc.
22. Ruts, holes and other disfigurement of mowed areas caused by mowing equipment shall be your responsibility to repair to original condition.
23. Landscape maintenance work shall be performed during the regular hours of 8.30 A.M. through 5:00 PM unless otherwise specified/approved by us due to uncontrollable weather situations.
24. You have the option to discontinue this Agreement if we schedule any works that would render these Services unnecessary during the Term.
